

# HOW TO WRITE IN JOHN PRATT Shelby Town Council

**PRINT OR SAVE THIS PAGE TO CARRY WITH YOU FOR ASSISTANCE IN WRITING IN CANDIDATES.**

You can either vote in person on Election Day, during early voting, or by mail.

On the ballot there is a **WRITE-IN** section below the list of candidates where voters can choose to write in the name of a candidate not listed on the ballot.

Write the full name of the person you want to vote for inside the WRITE-IN box.

If election officials cannot determine who you meant, your vote may not count.

If you made a mistake, you can request a new ballot.
